Condition Before Treatment

The object contains breaks, losses, tidelines, abrasions, insect damage and grime overall. The parchment is attached to the wooden backing with nails along the perimeter as well as animal glue overall on the verso. Areas of lifting/tears were previously stabilized with nails. A gilded, modern frame is adhered to the upper, right and bottom edges. The object was sealed in plastic to observe if any pests were present.

Preliminary Testing

Wet cleaning and drying cleaning were spot tested on the object in the lower left corner. Dry cleaning appeared to be almost as effective as wet cleaning.

Treatment Proposal

1. The object was photo-documented before treatment.
2. The object was vacuumed overall with a HEPA vacuum/soft brush.
3. The object was surface cleaned overall with a latex sponge.
4. Lifting areas were stabilized with wheat starch paste and dried under weight.
5. The modern gilded frame was mechanically removed.
6. The object was photo-documented after treatment.

Treatment Factors to Consider

- The tideline will still be visible after treatment
- Some areas of lifting cannot be set down due to the position of the parchment
